EPIPHANY CELEBRATION

Epiphany, sometimes called Three Kings Day or Twelfth Day, is celebrated on the twelfth day of Christmas and commemorates the visit of the three kings (magi or wise men) to Jesus. Although Christmas symbolizes the incarnation of God as human, it's Epiphany that symbolizes God's revelation to the entire world. At Christmas, the light shone forth, but only to a few around the manger. On Epiphany, the light shines to all nations and the old testament prophesy is fulfilled. A theme of Epiphany is "God as the light of the world", and it brings completion to the waiting of the Advent season—God's peace, love, hope and joy are offered to all.

We will celebrate Epiphany at Sardis on Wednesday, January 11th. A de-LIGHT-ful dinner will be served at 5:45 followed by Epiphany traditions old and new. We'll "chalk our doors" to ask God's blessing on our church home and all those who visit. Then we'll write our desires for peace, love, hope and joy onto paper lanterns and then send the light into the world. (Our lanterns are eco-friendly and 100% biodegradable.) Finally, we'll give thought to how we as individuals and a community can bring these desires to fruition. We hope you will be able to join us!



a note from the board of Dear Sardis Families, TRUSTFF

2016 has been a banner year in the life of Sardis Baptist Church. And because of your generosity, we are poised to do even bigger things in 2017. We want to express our gratitude for the financial contributions you've made in the past year – every penny you contribute makes a significant difference in enhancing the ministries of this place.

There were a number of highlights in 2016. We welcomed Hilary Kearns, our new Minister of Music. We dedicated our new picnic shelter. We introduced several new worship events including an Easter Sunrise Service, a Blessing of the Animals, Camp Sardis, and Communion Brunch. During our Saturdays of Service in Lent, Sardis members contributed more than 100 hours of community service to six local ministries, and in the Fall, Sardis raised more than \$2,500 for CROP Walk, and contributed more than 2,000 pounds of food to Loaves and Fishes. Our church also increased its year-over-year annual giving to the missions of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of North Carolina - we were one of only a handful of churches to do so. These dollars help support local and global missions, divinity schools to train our clergy, homes for both children and the aged, hospitals, the WMU and Baptist Men, the Alliance of Baptists, and countless other organizations that spread God's love in tangible ways.

Your generosity also benefited Sardis in subtle ways: one of our three main HVAC units was replaced, and funds are being set aside to replace another when the need arises; our office computer and financial software were upgraded; the baptistry's water heater was repaired; a Bluetooth speaker was purchased for the Meetinghouse; memorial benches were added to the Labyrinth; candles, flowers and other liturgical elements were purchased to help enhance worship. In addition, your contributions helped pay for utilities, staff salaries, fellowship activities and meals, administrative expenses including postage, printing, paper, custodial and landscaping services, educational materials, printed music and licensing, and insurance, just to name a few.

God is at work in and through the people of Sardis Baptist Church! As 2016 comes to an end, we offer our deepest thanks for you and your contributions. You give us bright hope for where God will lead Sardis in the year ahead.
