Lay leadership is vital to the success of any Baptist church. By definition, Baptists are congregationalists, which simply means that we are independent and self-governing. Members of our congregation elect the members of three governing boards as well as members of stewardship teams. Generally speaking, the **Board of Deacons** is responsible for overseeing the spiritual affairs of the church, the **Board of Trustees** for overseeing the administrative, business and legal affairs of the church, and the **Board on Stewards** for overseeing the recruitment of church leaders and volunteers.

It is time for Sardis friends to consider church leadership roles for service beginning February 16th, 2020. Nomination forms for open positions on our **Board of Deacons** and **Board on Stewards** have been distributed electronically through church email; paper copies are available in the church vestibule. (There are currently no open positions on our Board of Trustees.) Please give careful consideration to these leadership positions. The Nominating Team (made up of current members from each Board) will base recruitment of candidates on the results tallied from your nominations. Nominations close at midnight on Sunday, January 5th, so please do not delay your submissions. Only current members of Sardis Baptist may be considered for positions on our leadership boards.

The Board on Stewards is currently reaching out to Sardis friends regarding available stewardship roles. Prayerfully consider your gifts and how you may serve at Sardis. Following are areas of service:

- Building & Grounds maintenance of Sardis buildings and property
- Fellowship planning, preparation, setup and cleanup for fellowship meals and events
- Missions activities serving those beyond our building walls
- Mutual Care providing love and care to Sardis friends during times of great need
- Outreach building relationships with those outside the Sardis community
- Preschool/Children/Youth programming for our youngest friends at Sardis
- Worship Development collaboration with staff to plan worship
