DISCOVERY & DESIGN TEAM (WORK)

 - What brought us to Sardis?
 - How has pandemic affected our routines and rhythms?
- Used insight to form a guiding question

 - How we invite others into our calling


THE GUIDING QUESTION FOR SARDIS (WORKING FORM)
